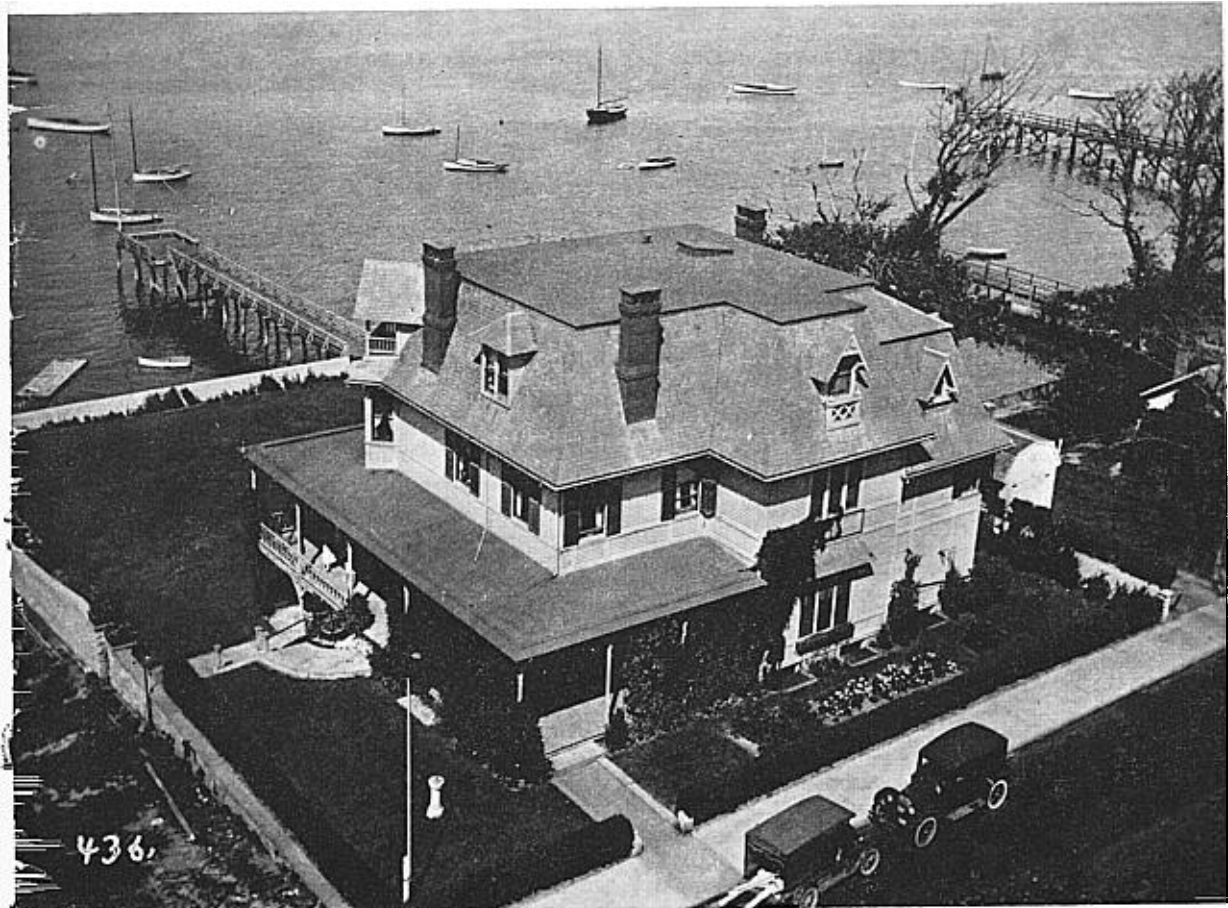

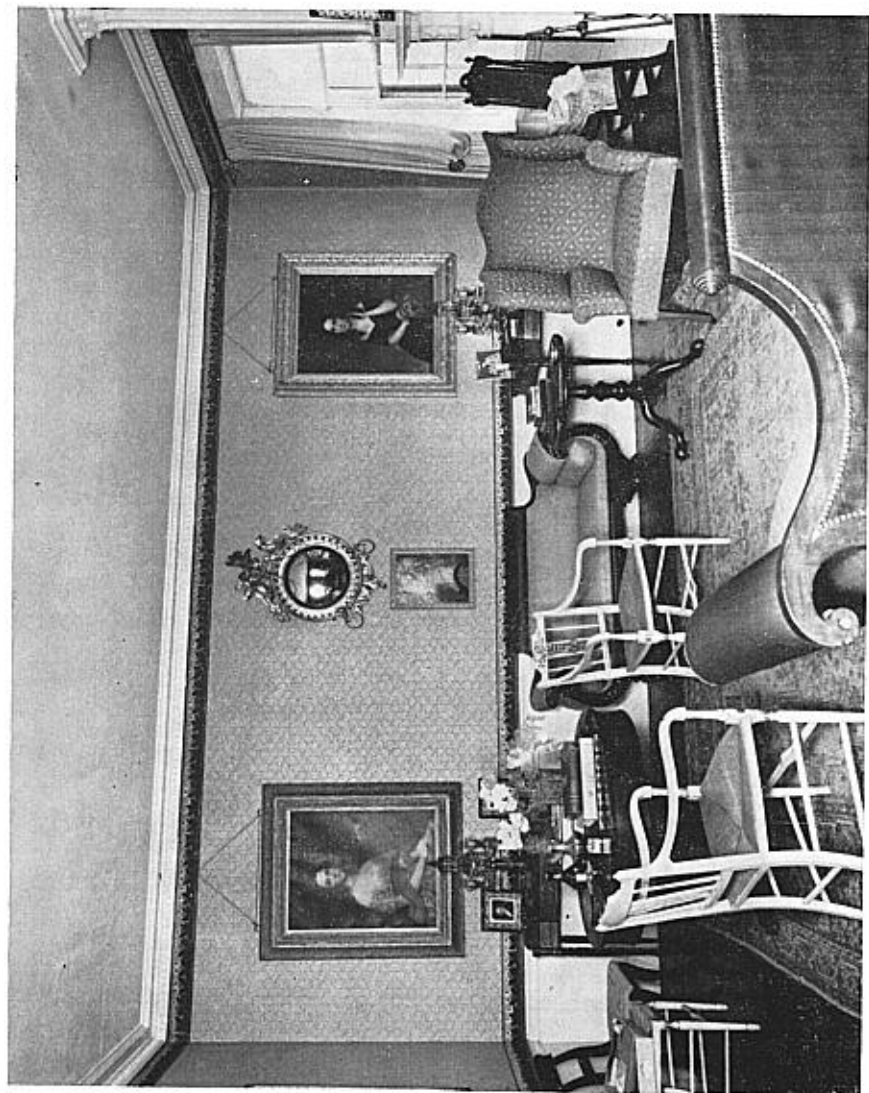
COVER: *Sanford-Covell House in Newport, Rhode Island, as it appeared about 1930.*
